Some of you have asked why we keep funds in "Reserve". This practice is highly recommended by the National Council of Nonprofits along with other Financial Experts. They recommend that we keep between 3 to 6 months of "Operating Expenses" in a cash reserve to cover our expenses. Therefore, we have purchased a CD in the amount of \$15,000 and have opened a Money Market account in the amount of \$15,000 to cover our expenses.

Many volunteers are needed to run this Club.
