Classes provide an in-depth view into numerous areas of law enforcement and are intended to enhance understanding, communication and partnerships between citizens and the Lee County Sheriff's Office.

Highlights include presentations from the following Units: SWAT, Aviation, Major Crimes, Corrections, Public Information and Economic Crimes, Demonstrations include Active Shooter, K9 and the Bomb Squad.

Participants also receive gun safety training at the Lee County Gun Range.

Thursday, August 28th – 9:30 am our guest speaker will be a representative from Blessing Backpacks Kids. The Blessings in a Backpack program steps-up by feeding children on the weekend. Every Friday afternoon, children receive backpacks filled kid-friendly, ready-to-eat with items. Students return every Monday morning with an empty backpack, a full stomach, and an eager mind. In the schools we work with in Lee and Collier County, test scores, reading skills, positive behavior, general health, and attendance have improved dramatically because of children getting the nourishment they need.

The Club does not buy pastries, donuts, cookies, etc. for the monthly meetings.
