Travel vs Activity

There have been questions raised about what is considered a travel event versus an activity. This is to provide some direction.

An activity is arranged by the Activities Committee headed up by Cheryl Samuels. Activities are local – no more than a 2.5-hour drive. Activities include items such as:

- Club Dining
- Local Museums
- Local Parks
- Craft Activities (such as painting)
- Boating with local charter companies

Activities are not overnight, nor do they require commercial transportation (planes, trains, chartered buses).
