The "LCSO robo dog" is Robbie, a robot dog used by the Lee County Sheriff's Office in Florida to assist deputies in dangerous situations and promote community engagement. Robbie is equipped with a 360-degree

camera for reconnaissance, can navigate complex terrain, and has been used in hostage situations and at community events. The LCSO acquired Robbie using funds from drug forfeiture, not taxpayer money.

We will have an Honor American Legion Guard demonstration, and Quilts of Valor will be gifting patriotic quilts to one service member per branch of service.
