Message from Our President

Increase in the price of dinner dance tickets when using a credit card. increased inflation over the last few years, businesses have been looking for different ways to meet the increased costs of doing business. Rather than continuing to raise prices some businesses have decided to charge an extra fee for customers paying by credit card (i.e. processing or service fee) to meet rising costs. The CCSC has tried very hard not to raise ticket prices because of the increased inflation and fees. However, because of the mounting monetary loss to the club due to the credit card processing fees, we find we must raise the cost of dinner dance tickets WHEN PLAYING WITH A CREDIT

CARD. Therefore, starting with the July 6th dinner dance, the cost of a ticket for members using a credit card will be \$35. The cost for non-members using a credit card will be \$40. The cost for those paying by check or cash remains the same: \$32 for members and \$37 for non-members.

If you have been paying by credit card and would prefer to avoid the additional cost, you can always purchase your ticket with a check at the membership meeting, Farmer Joe's, The Family Hardware store on 47th Terrace or the Lake Kennedy Senior Center.

Regardless of the payment method, when purchasing a ticket, please remember to include your meal choice, names of people to sit with, your phone number and email address. 
Activities


